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A field visit to local micro enterprises was organized by entrepreneur development cell in collaboration with institutions innovation council. The visit took place on 27-06-2022, around 90studentsfrom 2nd year took part in this field visit accomplished by 2 facility members. The fish breeding unit is a micro start-up with 1 crore investment and is first of its kind in Andhra Pradesh. It was found in 2019 by a young team - Dr. M.Vishwas Rao a marine biologist along with Mr. Moses and Mr. Dheeraj who shared the vision to establish an ornamental fish cluster in Kurnool city. They started this venture backed by AP fisheries board.It consists of an aqua lab, storage facility display units and aquarium units. Mr. Alok Moses and Dr. Vishwas explained thoroughly the operations and maintenance of the units to the students.
