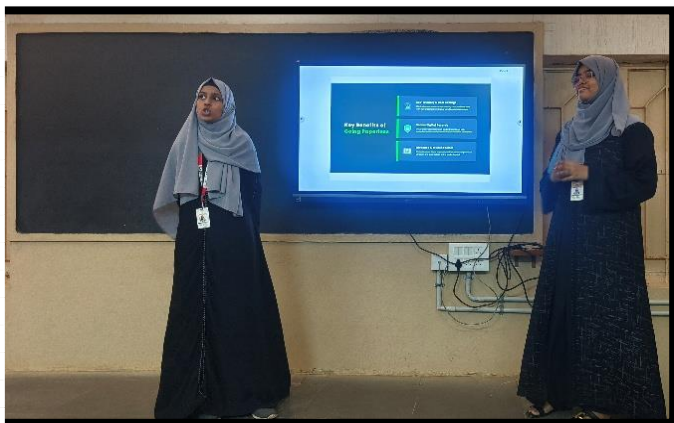

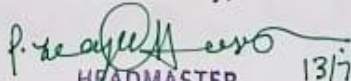

SYNOPSIS

SYNOPSIS

The Eco Club of St. Joseph's Degree College, Kurnool organized an **Environmental Sensitization Program** on 28 July 2026 to commemorate **World Nature Conservation Day**. The program was conducted with the theme "Nurture Nature, Secure the Future", aiming to create awareness among students about environmental conservation and the urgent need to protect the Earth's natural resources for future generations.

The Resource Person, **Dr. G. V. Swarnalatha**, Assistant Professor, Department of Biotechnology, Rayalaseema University, Kurnool, emphasized that environmental conservation is not merely the responsibility of governments and organizations but also the duty of every individual. She explained how rapid urbanization, deforestation, pollution, climate change, and the overexploitation of natural resources have resulted in biodiversity loss and ecological imbalance.

Dr. Swarnalatha explained the invaluable services provided by nature, including clean air, fresh water, food, medicines, fertile soil, and climate regulation. She highlighted the importance of biodiversity in sustaining agriculture, human health, and ecosystem stability.

The session further focused on India's remarkable biodiversity, highlighting important ecological regions such as the Western Ghats, the Himalayas, the Sundarbans, mangrove ecosystems, and Pulicat Lake. The speaker pointed out that although India occupies only about 2.4% of the world's land area, it supports nearly 8% of the world's biodiversity, making conservation efforts even more significant.

She also introduced students the practical approaches for environmental protection, encouraging simple yet effective actions such as planting and nurturing trees, conserving water and electricity, reducing single-use plastics, practicing waste segregation and recycling, protecting wildlife habitats, and participating in community environmental initiatives.

Overall, the Environmental Sensitization Program successfully inspired students to develop a positive attitude toward nature conservation and emphasized that small individual actions can create a lasting impact in building a greener, healthier, and more sustainable future.

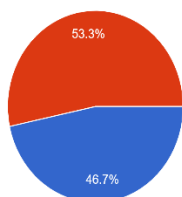

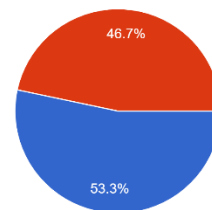
