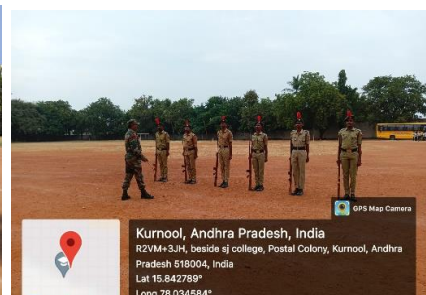
In addition to the **physical drills**, theory classes are held regularly, covering a wide range of **subjects** essential to the **NCC training**. The curriculum includes topics such as:

Organised ATC-III Camp (09-06-2025 to 18-06-2025) Conducted by 28(A) Bn, NCC Under the Leadership of CO Lt. Col B.S. Prasad

About the program:

St. Joseph's Degree College, Kurnool successfully organized the **Annual Training Camp (ATC-III)** from **09-06-2025 to 18-06-2025**, conducted by **28(A) Bn, NCC** under the leadership of **Commanding Officer Lt. Col. B. S. Prasad and AO Lt. Col Sasi Kumar**. The camp was designed as an intensive training programme aimed at developing **discipline, leadership qualities, physical fitness, and overall personality development** among NCC cadets. It also served as a crucial selection platform for various advanced NCC camps and competitions at the state and national levels.

The primary **objective of ATC-III** was to identify and **select deserving cadets for prestigious camps** such as the **Thal Sainik Camp (TSC), Republic Day Camp (RDC), firing competitions, Best Cadet category, and other Combined Annual Training (COC) camps**. In addition, the camp also focused on **selecting cadets for cultural activities and sports events**, ensuring the holistic development of participants. The training environment was highly disciplined, structured, and closely aligned with the standards of the National Cadet Corps.

The camp brought together cadets from different institutions, creating a diverse and competitive environment. This helped in **fostering unity, teamwork, and healthy competition** among cadets. The daily routine of the camp was strictly scheduled and included **physical training sessions, drill practice, classroom instruction, weapon training** and various **skill-based activities**. Early morning **physical exercises** were conducted to **improve stamina, strength, and endurance, while drill sessions focused on discipline, coordination, and teamwork**.

One of the **major components** of the camp was **firing training**. Cadets were trained in handling **.22 rifles** and were each cadet given practice sessions to **improve accuracy, concentration, and shooting skills**. Firing competitions were conducted as part of the selection process, where cadets were evaluated based on **grouping, accuracy, and snap-shooting ability**. These assessments played a significant role in shortlisting cadets for higher-level competitions and camps.

Physical fitness tests were another key aspect of the camp. Cadets were evaluated through exercises such as **push-ups, sit-ups, pull-ups** and a timed 2 km run. These tests were conducted to **assess endurance, strength, and overall physical fitness**. Only cadets who demonstrated consistency and high performance were considered for further selection.

The camp also included **training in obstacle courses**, which tested the **physical agility, courage, and coordination** of cadets. Activities such as **wall climbing, zigzag balancing, rope-based challenges, and ditch crossing** were part of the obstacle training. These exercises helped cadets **build confidence, overcome fear, and improve their problem-solving abilities in challenging situations**.

Map reading was another important skill taught during the camp. Cadets were trained to use a **Prismatic Compass and interpret topographical maps**. They learned how to **identify locations, determine directions, and understand grid references**. This training enhanced their **analytical skills and situational awareness**, which are essential qualities in military and leadership roles.

Field Craft and Battle Craft (FCBC) training sessions were also conducted, where cadets learned **survival techniques, camouflage methods, distance estimation, and field signaling**. Basic **health and hygiene practices** were also emphasized to ensure that cadets **maintained good physical and mental health during field** conditions. These sessions helped cadets understand the **practical aspects of field survival and military discipline**.

Apart from **military training**, the **ATC-III Camp** also gave importance to **cultural and sports activities**.
