## REPORT ON THE VISIT TO VIJAYA MILK DAIRY, KURNOOL

**Organising Department:** Zoology

Name of the Activity: Visit to Vijaya Milk Dairy

Purpose of Activity: To provide students with practical exposure to the dairy industry

**Date and Time:** 20th September 2024, 11:00 AM **Venue:** Vijaya Milk Dairy, A-Camp, Kurnool

**Number of Beneficiaries: 38** 

The Department of Zoology, St. Joseph's Degree College, Kurnool, organized an educational visit to Vijaya Milk Dairy on 20th September 2024. The visit aimed to offer B.Sc. Zoology 3rd-year students practical exposure to the operations of the dairy industry and its biological aspects. A total of 47 students, accompanied by faculty members, participated in this learning activity.

## **Purpose of the Visit**

The primary objective of the visit was to bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical application by exposing students to the processes involved in milk procurement, processing, quality testing, packaging, and distribution. The experience also helped students understand the role of zoology in the dairy industry, particularly in areas like livestock health and management.

#### **Details of the Visit**

The group reached Vijaya Milk Dairy at 10:45 AM and was warmly welcomed by the dairy officials. After a brief introduction about the dairy's history and its significance in the region, the students were divided into smaller groups for a guided tour of the facility.

## 2. **Processing Unit:**

## 3. Quality Testing Laboratory:

The students were taken to the quality testing lab, where they witnessed procedures for testing milk purity, fat content, and microbial safety. The staff demonstrated the use of advanced equipment like lactometers and chromatography machines.

## 4. Packaging and Distribution:

In the packaging section, students observed the automated machinery used for filling and

sealing milk packets. The distribution strategies, including cold chain management, were also discussed.

## 5. Role of Livestock Management:

The guides highlighted the significance of healthy livestock in ensuring high milk yield. They discussed animal nutrition, disease prevention, and the role of veterinarians in the dairy industry, which was particularly relevant to the students' curriculum.

The visit provided students with a holistic understanding of the dairy industry. Key takeaways included:

- Knowledge of milk processing and quality control techniques.
- Insights into the application of zoology in livestock management and food technology.
- Awareness of the importance of maintaining hygiene and safety standards in food production.

The visit concluded with an interactive session, where students asked questions about career opportunities in the dairy sector, sustainable practices, and the integration of modern technology. The dairy officials appreciated the students' enthusiasm and encouraged them to consider the dairy industry as a potential career field.
